What to bring:

Bible, notebook and pen(s), sleeping bag or bedding for bunk bed, pillow, towels, modest swimming apparel, play clothes for activities, chapel and competition attire, toiletries, flashlight, insect repellent, spending money for camp store and snack shop.

What NOT to bring:

Tobacco, alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, radios of any kind (clock radios included), iPods, tapes, CDs, Mp3 players, TVs, magazines, electronic games, cell phones, matches, fireworks, knives or weapons of any kind, clothing with worldly advertising (alcohol, rock, country music, etc.), questionable reading material.

Ladies' Code of Conduct:

- Swimwear (culottes with dark top ONLY)
- Modest, loose-fitting skirts, dresses, culottes (skirt like); **NO GAUCHOS**. They must be 2 inches below the knee. NO straight skirts. NO slits. NO hip-hugger skirts. NO tight clothing. NO whiskering or fade spots.
- Modest tops and blouses. NO sleeveless tops or dresses. NO cap sleeve tops or dresses. NO belly tops. NO crop tops.
- NO sun dresses with narrow straps and low necklines. NO form-fitting or sheer dresses.
- NO pants of any style, jam shorts, nor sweatpants.
- Dress clothes for chapel services and chapel competition.
- Make-up and jewelry in moderation.
- Modest sleepwear (nightgowns ONLY, no pajama-type sleepwear).

Gentlemen's Code of Conduct:

- Swimwear (dark T-shirt and pants, cut-off pants, or modest swimwear)
- NO sleeveless shirts.
- Gentlemen MUST wear pants for all activities; no shorts or sweatpants.
- Hair MUST be neatly cut and off the ears and collar.
- NO earrings, necklaces, or bracelets (medical IDs are okay).
